- Died:** August 19 (Feast Day), 1680 age 78 in Caen, Normandy, France
- Patron Saint:** Caen, France; Diocese of Baie-Comeau, Quebec; Eudists; Ri, France
- Beatified:** April 25, 1909 by Pope Pius X
- Canonized:** May 31, 1925 by Pope Pius XI
